On behalf of the Core and Scientific Committees, we are very pleased to announce that **HIV Drug Therapy in the Americas** will take place between 7–10 May 2014 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

This innovative meeting in the region builds on the first meeting in the series which took place in June 2013 in São Paulo. The meeting brings together clinicians and researchers involved the treatment of HIV.

The 'Americas' scientific programme will be regionally-focussed providing opportunities to hear of recent advances and developments in the field of HIV infection, discuss and review therapeutic strategies, and consider ideas and learnings for future treatment. A mix of keynote lectures, plenary sessions and interactive case-based presentations will take place in a multi-lingual (English, Spanish and Portuguese) single-session format. Time will be set aside for discussion and networking both within the formal programme and informally during refreshment breaks and the scientific poster reception.

The scientific programme is currently under development by the Scientific Committee. Abstract submissions are invited for this Congress and will be published as a supplement to the *Journal of the International AIDS Society*. Submission will be electronic via an online submission system available on the Congress website www.hivamericas.org. Abstract submission will open in November 2013 and the deadline for receipt of abstracts is **Friday 28 February 2014**. Individuals wishing to submit a late breaker will be able to do so providing a letter of intent is received by the secretariat by the regular abstract deadline of Friday 28 February. The letter of intent should include information about the proposed abstract and why it should be considered as a late breaker. The final abstract must be received by **Wednesday 19 March 2014** to be considered by the Congress. Abstracts under peer review and will be considered for oral or poster presentation at the Congress.

Abstract submission categories will be in line with the main programme themes of the congress. Full details including submissior criteria, categories and deadlines will be available on the website.

Registration

Participation in the Congress is open to clinicians and researchers throughout the world interested in the exchange of information on drug therapy in HIV infection. Registration information is available via the Congress website www.hivamericas.org. Registration will formally open in November 2013 and may be made up to and including Friday 25 April 2014.
